



Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for your interest in enrolling your child at Merrimac State School.

Any student whose principal place of residence is within the school's catchment area is entitled to enrol at the school. Parents or legal guardians who wish to enrol their child at the school will need to demonstrate that the student's principal place of residence is within the catchment area. Current proof of residency at the address indicated on the enrolment form can be provided by each of the following:

- One Primary source – a current tenancy agreement, or rates notice, or unconditional contract of sale showing the same address as the parent/legal guardian's name
- One Secondary source – a utility bill (eg. Electricity, gas) showing the same address as the parent/legal guardian's name

Information the school may require includes:

- Child's Birth Certificate (preferable) or passport
- Information about the child's medical conditions, medication (if applicable)
