



Schedule of Fees and Charges for Merrimac State School

The Education Act (General Provisions) 2006, allows for schools to charge fees or request voluntary contributions for a range of activities. The schedule below identifies those areas for which fees or contributions may be sought during the school year.

Fees will be charged for the following activities:

1. School Excursions, including transport
2. School Camps, including transport
3. Hire of musical instruments and program participation that falls outside the standard curriculum (such as additional instrumental instruction)
4. Sporting and artistic programs that extend beyond the core curriculum (such as District, Regional, State and National sporting carnivals, Musical showcases, and Eisteddfod) including any associated transport costs
5. Swimming/Surf Awareness Levies, including transport
6. Participation in the International Exchange Program
7. Educational services provided such as Performance Education and Life Education
8. Year 6 Graduation and end of year activities

Chargeable activities are invoiced to parents and are to be paid after receiving the invoice via email to the nominated parent. Payments should be made at least 3 days prior to the due date to ensure funds reach the school account before cut off.
