As you may have heard, Merrimac State School will be implementing a new **Sun Safe Policy** in 2022. MSS currently has a NO HAT - NO PLAY Policy, with students being able to wear any school-coloured, non-branded hat. During 2022 this will change, and the school will require all students to wear a sun safe hat that protects their face, neck and ears. The P&C are working with the school to find a suitable Broad-Brim, Bucket or Legionnaire Style hat that will suit the schools style and needs. As part of the roll-out (expected Term 2), each student will receive one free hat to ensure that families are not impacted by this change. This cost will be shared by the School and the P&C. There will be further communication closer to the date.






